COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER

A Community Health Worker (CHW) is a frontline public health worker who serves as a link to services and improve service delivery. A CHW also may provide outreach, community education, information to support individuals in the community, social support, and advocacy.

CERTIFIED PEER RECOVERY SPECIALIST

A Certified Peer Recovery Specialist has at least 2 years experience with substance use or mental health recovery. They provide a variety of services including advocacy, mentoring and education regarding recovery pathways, wellness tools and linkages to treatment and local recovery community resources.

- 46 hours of training
- 500 hours of internship
- 25 hours of Registered Peer Supervision
- Exam fee

All VoH students receive training on ethics, professionalism, resume writing, interviewing, job retention techniques and working wellness plans.
